7-Harbors Board does not have scheduled meetings over the winter but we have had some discussions about a few issues. One of the troubling issues is the fact that you are paying to maintain the roads, bridge and the boat launches and yet people who are not paying the fees want to add to your burden. For example, someone has placed in many of our mailboxes an open request to rent a boat well on the lake from anyone. This family sounds nice enough. In addition, the closing of the public launch at Mitchell's is likely to produce some people who want to guilt you into to loaning out your key to the launch. These people do not have a right to use your launch. Where will they be when we need money to repair the launches and everything else? You will be left holding the bag, not them. Our maintenance fees for the subdivision reflect one fee per property. Additional boats and cars for someone who does not live here and does not pay for the maintenance will add extra cost to you.

So remember, letting someone use your key to the boat launch or renting out a spot on the lake is a violation of the bylaws. Even doing it out of the goodness of your heart, without money exchanging hands, is a violation. Moreover, the bylaws can be a handy excuse for declining to let someone use your property this way. For example, I had a sister in law who was not a good person. When my brother asked to keep his boat at my house, I cited the bylaws. I never had to tell him that it would be a cold day in you know where before she could keep a boat at my house.

The Bike Parade continues to be a source of good times and good will in our neighborhood. Over the winter I received a call from one of our members already asking the date of the bike parade. She wanted to plan ahead for her family to be here for it. It is always the same day as the White Lake Citizens League fireworks, this year on Saturday, July 2. 
